So the entire pre-registration is \$60 with no extra charge from Bike-Reg for registering with them. Race day registration will open at 8:00 AM on Saturday and will close at 11:45 AM. There will be one day USAC licenses available for \$10 on both days. On Sunday, race day registration will open at 6:15 AM and will close 20 min before your event. Both days a one day USAC license will be available. For those that do not pre-register, there will be a extra \$10 race day registration fee. Pre-registration will close Thursday August 12th at midnight. Event coordinator reserves the right to combine races in event of not enough participants in one category.

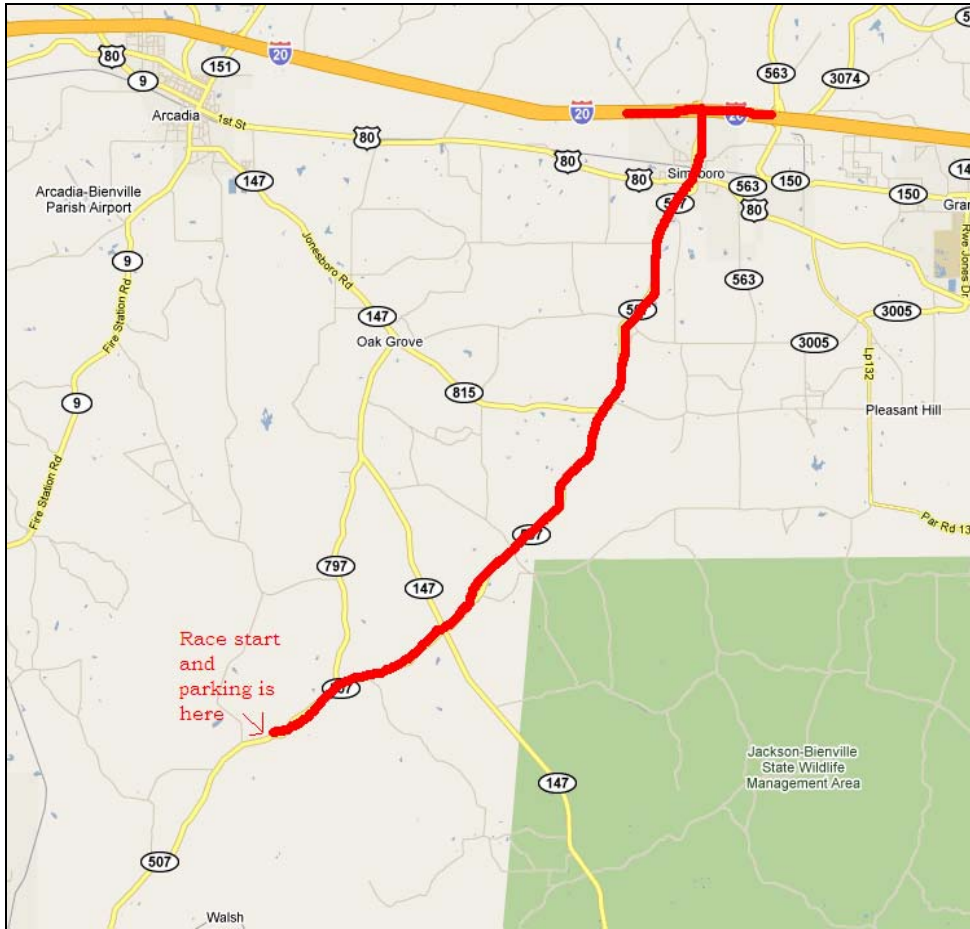

The races will be held near Ruston, Louisiana and the hotel and restaurant accommodations will be in the town of Ruston. Exits 86-84 off of I-20 are the exits for Ruston. The road race on Saturday will be held in Bienville Parish South of Grambling. The easiest way to get to the race start is to exit I-20 at exit 77 for hwy 507. Then head south until you cross hwy 147. There will be signs along the road directing you to the race route until you reach race volunteers directing you to parking.

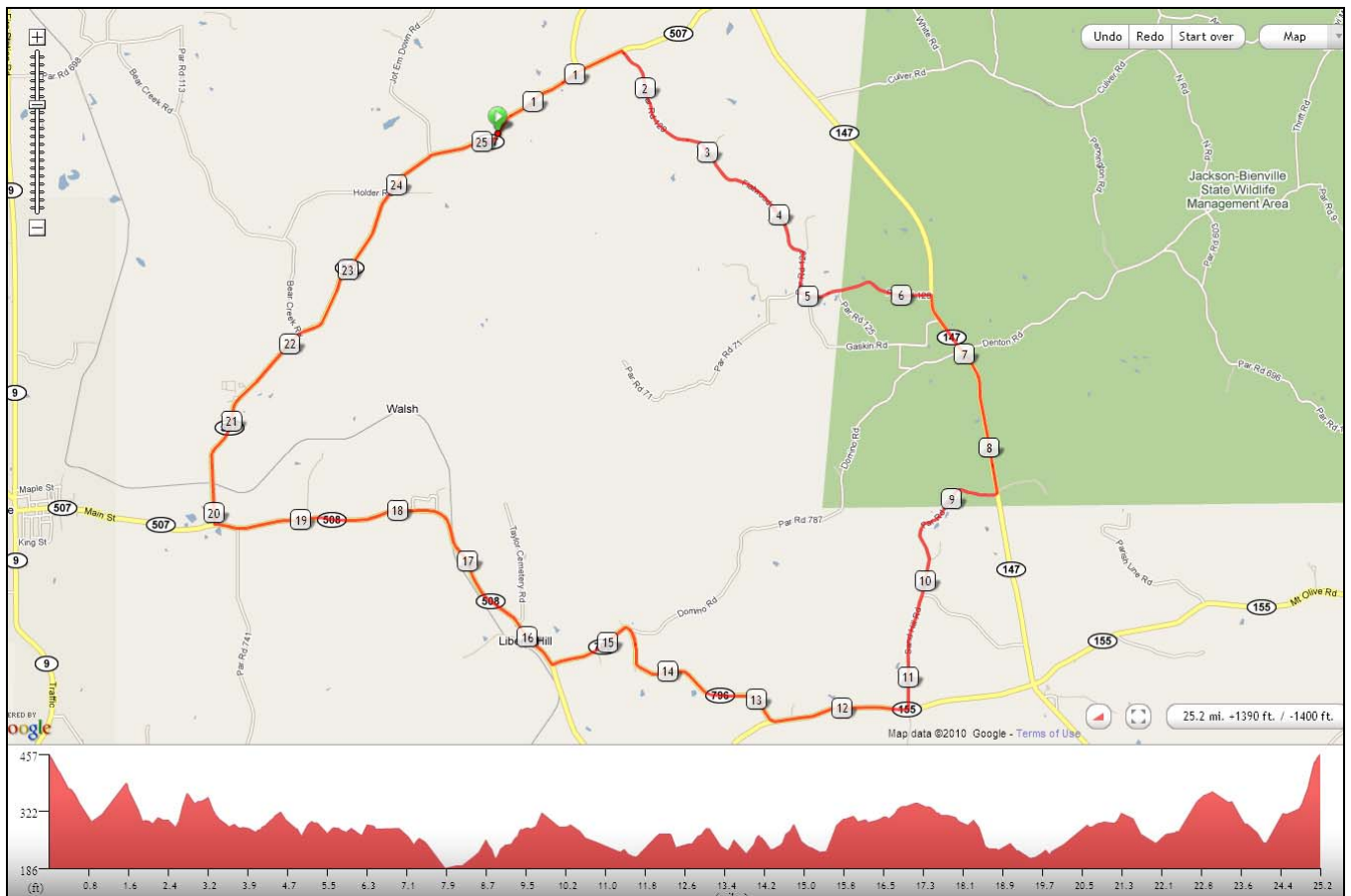
Road race start for Saturday road race!



Mt. Driskill Road Race

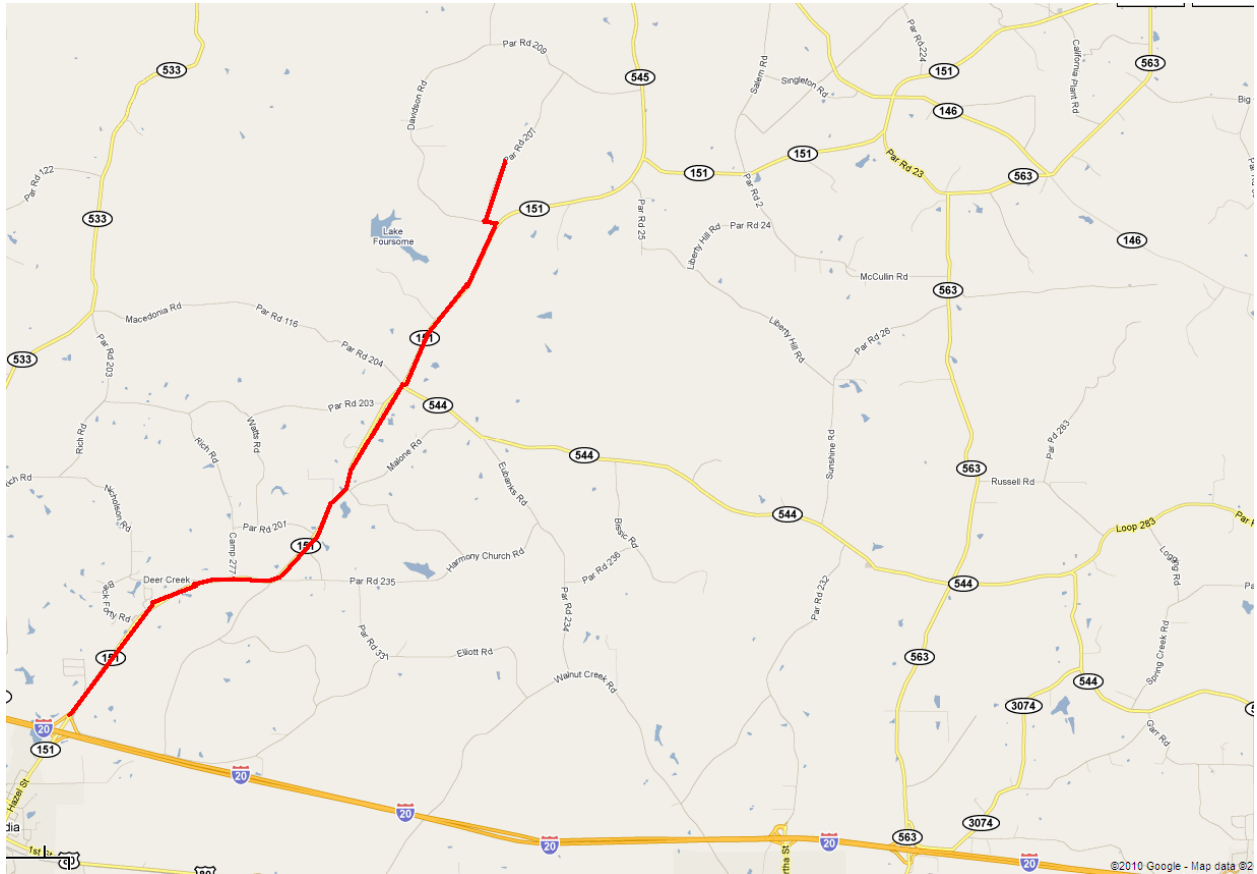
25.2 mile loop – 1,400 ft of elevation change per lap!

The road race course is a very hilly course with many short steep climbs and one that you won't forget! The top of Mt. Driskill is where the race will start as well as finish. It is also the highest point in Louisiana! Racers will ride up the steep side of Driskill (1.2 mile climb) and down the shallow side. The climb is gradual until the last .3 miles where it jumps up to a peak of 18% grade. During the race there are very few straight flat areas. This is a climber's course! More Climbing than the Rouge-Roubaix in only two laps! Cat 1,2's will be doing three laps for 75 miles! Come try it out! Super fast course with good roads and great hills to climb! For those races that have multiple laps a hot spot will be awarded for the first 3 racers to reach the hot spot. These hot spots will be for omnium points and will be 5 to 1st, 3 to 2nd, and 1 to 3rd.



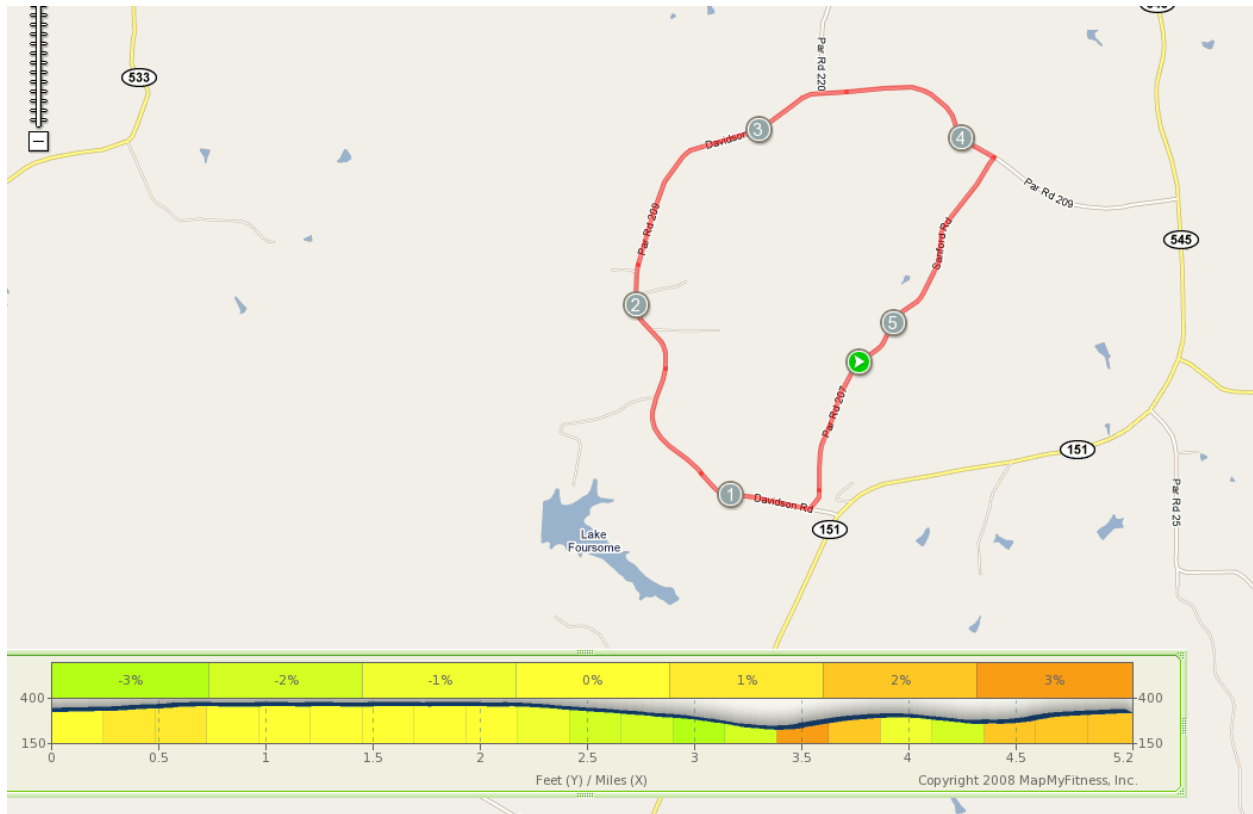
Directions to Sunday Arcadia Road Race

Exit off of I-20 onto hwy 151 headed north. Follow north 6.8 miles to Davidson road and take a left onto Davidson. Take the first right off Davidson and continue to race start. Route will have signs for direction to start. Parking is on the side of the road and vehicles must pull **COMPLETELY OFF THE ROAD!!!**



Sunday Arcadia Road Race Course 5.2 Mile Loop

Sunday's race is near Arcadia held on rural back roads. There are only two turns so an easy route to follow. The course is mostly rolling hills with some fast descents, but finishes each lap with the dreaded triple headed monster! A couple laps around and it won't seem so easy any more. Once again a climber's paradise! Follows the theme of the weekend quite nicely! There is 300 feet of climbing per lap!
